**Reading I, Acts 13:14, 43-52**

<sup>14</sup> The others carried on from Perga till they reached [Antioch](#) in Pisidia. Here they went to [synagogue](#) on the [Sabbath](#) and took their seats.

<sup>43</sup> When the meeting broke up many [Jews](#) and devout converts followed Paul and Barnabas, and in their talks with them Paul and Barnabas urged them to remain faithful to the [grace God](#) had given them.

<sup>44</sup> The next [Sabbath](#) almost the whole town assembled to hear the word of God.

<sup>45</sup> When they saw the crowds, the Jews, filled with jealousy, used blasphemies to contradict everything Paul said.

<sup>46</sup> Then Paul and Barnabas spoke out fearlessly. 'We had to proclaim the word of [God](#) to you first, but since you have rejected it, since you do not think yourselves worthy of eternal life, here and now we turn to the gentiles.

<sup>47</sup> For this is what the [Lord](#) commanded us to do when he said: I have made you a light to the nations, so that my [salvation](#) may reach the remotest parts of the earth.'

<sup>48</sup> It made the [gentiles](#) very happy to hear this and they gave thanks to the [Lord](#) for his message; all who were destined for eternal [life](#) became believers.

<sup>49</sup> Thus the word of the [Lord](#) spread through the whole countryside.

<sup>50</sup> But the [Jews](#) worked on some of the devout women of the upper classes and the leading men of the city; they stirred up a [persecution](#) against Paul and Barnabas and expelled them from their territory.

<sup>51</sup> So they shook the dust from their feet in protest against them and went off to Iconium; but the converts were filled with joy and the Holy Spirit.
